LISTEN TO THE SOUNDS OF THE OLD TIME JAM BAND!

When you take a quick break of adding awesome yarns to your stash and figuring out what craft is going to be your next adventure, head over to the picnic tables, grab a bite and listen to the sounds of **Hallockville's Old Time Jam Band!**

Twice each month the Hallockville Old Time Jam Band meets at the Naugles Barn to get together and play old airs and tunes such as John Brown's Dream, Shove that Pigsfoot, and Cluck Old Hen (just to name a few!). If you'd like to join in, bring your instrument. Just want to listen? Come on down!

DEMONSTRATION DESCRIPTIONS

- **Blacksmith:** (*Sunday only*) Christopher Magee demonstrates the time-honored skills required to turn hot metal into functional pieces.
- **Carding/Spinning/Drop Spindle:** The Spinning Study Group of Long Island show how to turn fiber into yarn. Ongoing demos.
- **Dyeing:** Adele Michelsen explains how fibers can be colorfully transformed using acid based dyes. Visit her in the Fiber Market.
- **Herding:** Judianne Davis works with her border collies in a fascinating demonstration of sheep herding.
- **Needle Felting:** (*Sunday only*) Vicki Fleming demonstrates this technique of using wool to create wonderful pieces.
- **Rug Hooking:** The Peconic Ruggers practice a folk art that dates back to the Revolution. Visit them at their table in the Fiber Market.
- **Shearing:** Tabbethia Haubold of LI Livestock Co. demonstrates shearing sheep and llamas.
- **Quilting:** The Quilt and Stitch Group of Hallockville Museum Farm demonstrates this traditional textile art and craft.
- **Weaving:** The Paumanok Weavers Guild and the New York Handweavers Guild will demonstrate this technique.
- **Felt Making Demo:** Joy Muller-McCoola demonstrates the technique of turning raw wool into felted fabric. Visit her in the Fiber Market.
- **Bead Weaving on a Loom:** (*Saturday Only*) Renowned artist, Janice Grzyb demonstrates working with fine glass beads on a loom.
- **Woodcarving:** Watch the Hallockville wood carvers create charming pieces using the tools of their trade.
- **Machine Knitting:** A knitting machine is a mechanical system of knitting at high speed.
- **Knitting:** Try you hand or watch the pros turn yarn into beautiful knitted goods.
- **Yarn Wrapped Basket:** Want to use up odds and ends of your stash yarn? This is the perfect project to de-stash with!
